

Leo-Cedarville Park Meeting Notes

March 9, 2015

In attendance:

The park board reviewed and approved the previous meeting notes.

The park board approved vouchers.

John Eastes clerk treasurer reviewed the budget report.

Aimee and Jack from Martin Riley reviewed the draft plan of the Park Master Plan. The park board reviewed the entire draft and submitted changes for the final plan to be submitted for public inspection.

The board discussed in detail many elements of the plan and reorganized some of the sections.

Aimee will make changes and Peg will redistribute to the board the week of March 16, 2015. The plan will be on inspection the March 23-April 3, 2015 at the Town Hall.

The board will hear public comment on Monday April 6, 2015 at 6 p.m. at the Town Hall.

The board will move to adopt the Park Plan by Resolution and submit the plan if adopted to the Department of Natural Resources for approval.

The board reviewed the License to Enter Land agreement as submitted by the Leo-Cedarville Foundation for the July 3 and 4, 2015 festival. The board was in consensus and signed the document.

A motion was made by Dirk to gift the foundation \$1100.00 for the Freedom Festival. Mark seconded the motion, the motion was passed unanimously.

Peg reviewed a request for a rental that involved sales of retail items by a group of vendors. The board discussed the pavilion contract in great length. Dirk made the motion to allow for this rental. Mark seconded the motion, the motion passed unanimously.

The park board discussed the use of the pavilions at Riverside Gardens and its growing popularity. The board discussed ways to raise revenue to run the park efficiently. Peggy suggested that the rates of the pavilions at Riverside should be amended. Mark made the motion to raise the grand pavilion rental to \$150.00 dollars a day for non-residents and \$125.00 dollars a day for residents, and that the small pavilions be raise to \$85.00 a day for non-residents and \$75.00 a day for residents. Dirk seconded the motion, the motion passed unanimously.

Dirk moved to table all other items on the agenda to the next regular meeting date. All those in attendance concurred.
