

Leo-Cedarville, Indiana Title VI Notice to the Public

Leo-Cedarville, Indiana hereby gives public notice that it is the Town's policy to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987, and the related statutes and regulations in all programs and activities. Title VI requires that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, disability, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, low income status or limited English proficiency be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any Federal Aid Highway program or other activity for which Leo-Cedarville, Indiana receives federal financial assistance.

Any person who believes they have been aggrieved by an unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI has a right to file a formal complaint with Leo-Cedarville, Indiana. Any such complaint must be filed with the Town within sixty (60) days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence.
